

**Lost River Cave and Valley:** Tourist Court, to the right of the little white house (by the waterwheel), in the bushes behind a rock.

**WKU / Jonesville:** Across the street from Jonesville there's a parking lot. Look towards the watertower, in the grass/bushes in front of the sub station. It's between the guy wires.

**WKU / Kentucky Museum:** At the front of the Museum, behind Lincoln, next to the far left door hidden behind the vent cover.

**WKU / Fort Lytle:** Hidden in a crevice in the rock wall below the bridge, on the left just before you go under the bridge.

**Fort C.F. Smith:** Head 39 paces from the reader rail to the right toward the big tree next to the embankment. Then head 35 paces from that tree towards the little valley to the left of the playground. The bag is in a hole in a tree on the right.

**Fort on Baker Hill:** Pull into driveway between two entryway pillars. Box is hidden in brush on top of right-hand wall.

**Fort Webb:** Walk from parking area towards large staircase at rear of Fort. Box is hidden halfway, on left in rock crevice near tree.

**Riverview, Hobson's Hill:** Left side of house, to left of white bench between planter and building.
