



# Gifts, Gears & Gadgets **Bowling Green Area**

A trip to the beautiful Bowling Green, Kentucky area is something both men and women will enjoy. The shopping, browsing, beauty and tranquility of the area conveys a feeling of "I'm not ready to leave."

Your first day will take you to the Kentucky Museum featuring a one-of-a-kind collection of artifacts. The gift shop carries Kentucky-made products, everything from Chenille Teddy Bears to gourmet sauces, cigars and hand-made pottery. You'll even have a chance to watch Mitchell Rickman in his studio as he creates beautiful pottery from a lump of clay. Lunch at the 1869 Shaker Tavern, a tour of the Shaker Museum and a visit into the Jasper Springs Gift Shop rounds out the day.



Your second day begins with a visit to the world class National Corvette Museum and Corvette Store. Then you'll head to downtown Bowling Green where you'll visit the Spot Cash Store, a men's store that has remained virtually unchanged since it opened in 1929. Fountain Square Park is located in the heart of downtown and features fine antiques and home accessory shops. Several locally-owned eateries are open for lunch.

Then it's on to Smiths Grove, just minutes from Bowling Green. Approximately nine antique shops are within walking distance of each other, and an ice cream shop make the experience even more enjoyable.



The third day begins with a behind the scenes visit to Chaney's Dairy Barn. You'll see the

creation of sweet treats and browse Kentucky gifts. From there you back up in time when you tour Riverview Historic Home. The gift shop offers Kentucky crafted items, foods, classic children's toys as well as Victorian linens, stationery and much more.

You can also take in the Wild Bird and Nature Store. This unusual store carries an assortment of garden and nature oriented gifts. Lunch at Culvers, then head to Greenwood Mall where you can shop over 100 stores. Oh yes, there's an antique-style carousel ride for those who enjoy a bit of nostalgia.

A stop at Greenwood Spirits Shoppe / Country Ham & Deli just may be in order to finish out the day. Kentucky country hams, cheeses, bourbon, cigars and candies are a must!
