This evening will bowl you over as you party at the Southern Lanes Entertainment Center with everything from ice skating to mini golf!



Your second day begins with a prehistoric adventure at Dinosaur World. Then you'll venture to the Outback at Kentucky Down Under. How often

can you snap a picture of your adorable kids with a Tyrannosaurus Rex and a Kangaroo in the same day? Next, you'll go below to the fascinating world of caves at the American Cave Museum. For dinner you'll have American fare at Wha-Bah where you can show off your chef skills on their huge indoor grill.

Corvettes, Caves, Cows and Color describes your third day in Bowling Green. First, you'll visit the National Corvette Museum and see why the Corvette is America's favorite sports car, and try their interactive Pit Crew Challenge.
